## How to Identify Classes at UWA

Classes are called "modules" in the UK, and "course" typically refers to a student's degree program. At UWA, "Part I" refers to first year modules and "Part 2" refers to second-and-third year modules. Please keep in mind that UWA offers year-long modules as well and Spring-only students will not be able to take these classes. A full semester workload is 60 UWA credits.

The module's number indicates the level of the class, as well as the number of credits. For example: EC10510: Economic Principles 1  
EC=Economics, 1=first year module, 05=individual module number, 10=number of UWA credits.
