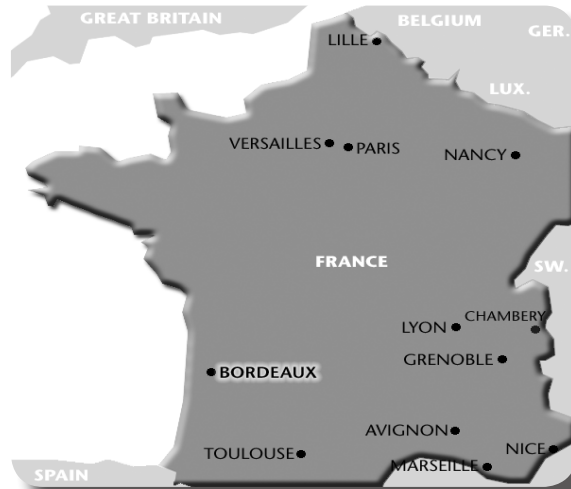

## THE PROGRAM

Bordeaux, the most well known city in France outside of Paris, is the capital of France's Southwest region, Aquitaine. The Aquitaine is made up of the Gironde, Dordogne, Lot et Garonne, Landes and Pyrénées Atlantiques regions, and just under 3 million people live and work here of whom 800,000 live in Bordeaux. At the forefront of electronic and information technology, biochemistry, the health industry, environmental and agricultural innovation, Bordeaux is today, as in its historic past, a hive of cultural and commercial activity. L'Institut d'Études Politiques Bordeaux is a short journey by car, bus or tramway to the historic, cultural and commercial centre of Bordeaux. Bordeaux's most vibrant nightlife is also to be found further up the banks of the river towards the Saint Jean international train terminal in an area known locally as the Quays. According to student tradition, the ideal pick-me-up after a night on the Quays is a rare-cooked steak and chips opposite the early morning Capucins food market.

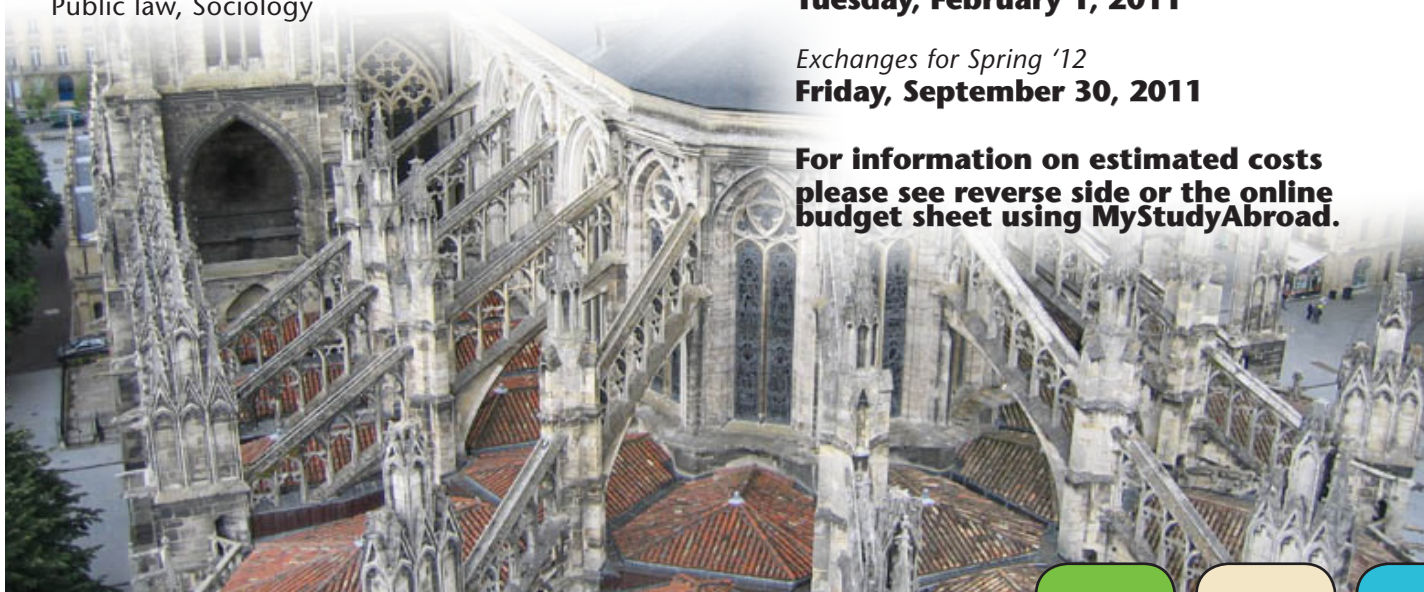
