## THE PROGRAM

Earn 6 credits while studying French and European agricultural practices at Ecole d'Ingénieurs de PURPAN for four weeks, followed by a four week internship on a family-run vineyard or farm during the summer! Courses include European culture and agriculture, European animal production, crop production, food processing, viticulture and enology.

Internship placements include animal production (dairy/beef cattle, sheep/goat milk, swine and horse), agro-tourism, plant production (main crop, horticulture) and in vineyards or wineries. Live with a family for full immersion in the French lifestyle while partaking in all aspects of a family-run agri-business.

Courses are taught in English, no French language experience required. Program fee includes housing, meals, cultural excursions and local transportation.

Ecole d'Ingénieurs de PURPAN is an institution that focuses on life sciences, agriculture, agri-food marketing and management. Located in the Southern town of Toulouse, a city of about 300,000, it features a large student population with many entertainment options. It is near many of Europe's most popular cultural attractions.

Semester options, taught in French (excluding the internship), are also available. Please speak with the Education Abroad Office for more information.
