THE PROGRAM

Since its founding in 1898 the University of St.Gallen for Business Administration, Economics, Law and Social Sciences concentrates on the education of tomorrow's leaders in business, public administration, and law. As one of Europe's smaller universities with 6,500 students, it is home to Switzerland's largest business faculty. With accreditation both from EQUIS and AACSB International the university is both a well established and internationally recognized institution throughout Europe.

Rolling hills, snowy peaks and Lake Constance form the panorama surrounding St.Gallen. Founded in 610 St.Gallen later became famous for its Abbey Library, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This historical background lends the city a special atmosphere characterized by narrow pedestrian streets in the old town, quaint shops, and cozy restaurants. Germany, Austria and Liechtenstein are so close that you can see them from many nearby hilltops. The University overlooks the city yet is within easy walking distance to the center of town and the main train station.
