Kansai Gaidai was first established as a private language school in 1945. Exchange students have access to a variety of courses within the Asian Studies Program, which receives over 600 international students yearly from all around the world. At Kansai, students can opt to live with a homestay family or in the international student residence halls. In addition to the myriad of athletic and cultural clubs, there are several programs geared specifically towards international students, such as the Speaking Partner Program, the Experience Japan Program, and a Home Visit Program for students who live in the residence halls.

Hirakata City is an hour train ride from both Kyoto and Osaka, giving students easy access to two of Japan's greatest cultural centers.
